PARRISH & HEIMBECKER // *Yorkton, Saskatchewan*

Construction is nearing completion at Parrish & Heimbecker's new shuttle train terminal in Yorkton, SK.

This slipformed workhouse incorporates 20 bins including eight 21'x140' tall silos and 12 interstice bins. The facility also includes a 500 metric tonne per hour "dump through" truck scale and receiving system, a 1,500 metric tonne per hour reclaim/

rail shipping system, and a 272 metric tonne per hour truck loadout. The two 58' diameter x 130' tall annex silos store enough grain to load a unit train. Reclaim out of these bins to the bulkweigher is 1,500 metric tonnes per hour. This facility receives, stores, and ships a variety of prairie grains, including wheat, barley, canola, oats, and soybeans.

ABC AWARD OF EXCELLENCE

Todd & Sargent received the 2022 Associated Builders and Contractors of Iowa Award of Excellence in the category of General Construction - Commercial (Over \$10 million). The award was presented for House of Raeford's poultry feed mill in Simsboro, Louisiana. Criteria for the award included safety, complexity of the project, unique challenges, and innovation.

The Simsboro crew battled adverse weather including heavy rain and intense heat from nearby Tropical Storm Cristobol during the feed mill slip and a short shut down from Hurricane Laura during the grain silo slip and impacts from the Covid-19 pandemic. They showed their commitment to safety during the project through toolbox safety talks, constant jobsite coordination, and specialized safety trainings to complete this project's 213,389 onsite man-hours with zero lost-time accidents.

"We had a vision of what we wanted, and Todd & Sargent helped us turn that vision into a reality," said Michael Newton, Head of Milling Operations at House of Raeford. "We have thoroughly enjoyed working with the men and women at Todd & Sargent and we look forward to collaborating with them again on future projects."

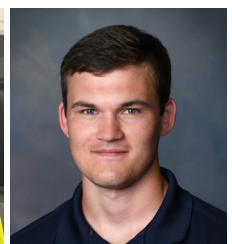

INVICTUS GAMES
