Construction is nearing completion at United Cooperative's new dairy feed mill.

T&S slipformed the 8,000 ton per week feed mill in October 2022 and loadout structure in April 2023. The mill features both pelleting and flaking lines as well as a variety of different dairy feeds and mineral pre-mix. The finished product line includes tender blender mixers that allow molasses and fat applications downstream. Feed from this mill will be delivered via bulk feed trucks or sold as bagged feed to local farmers.
